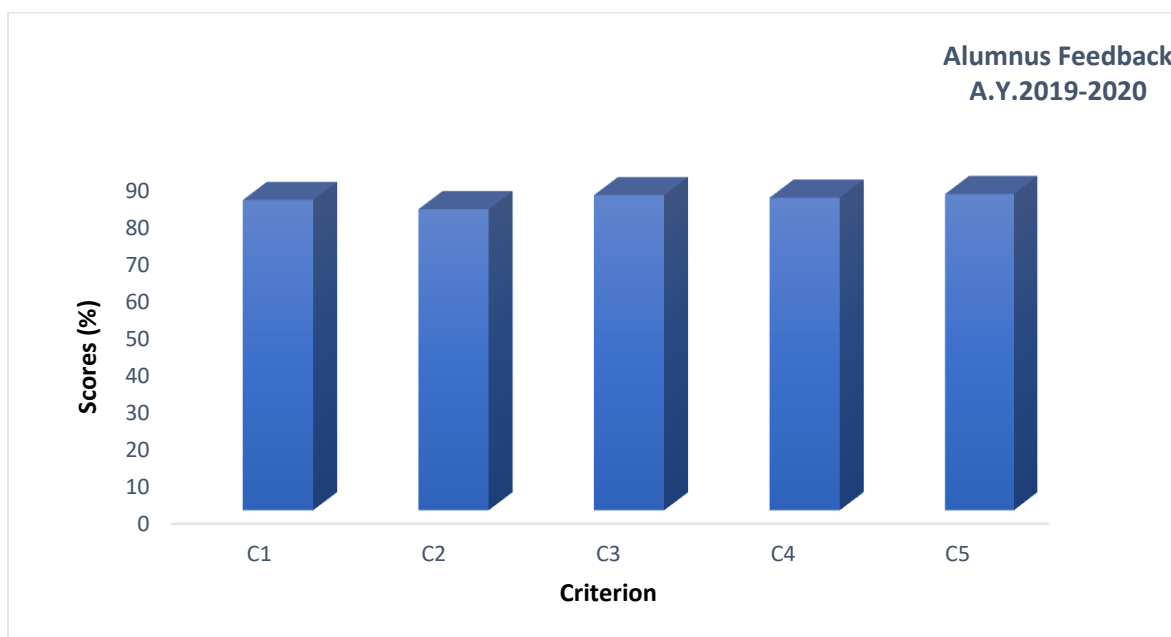

C5	Communication skills

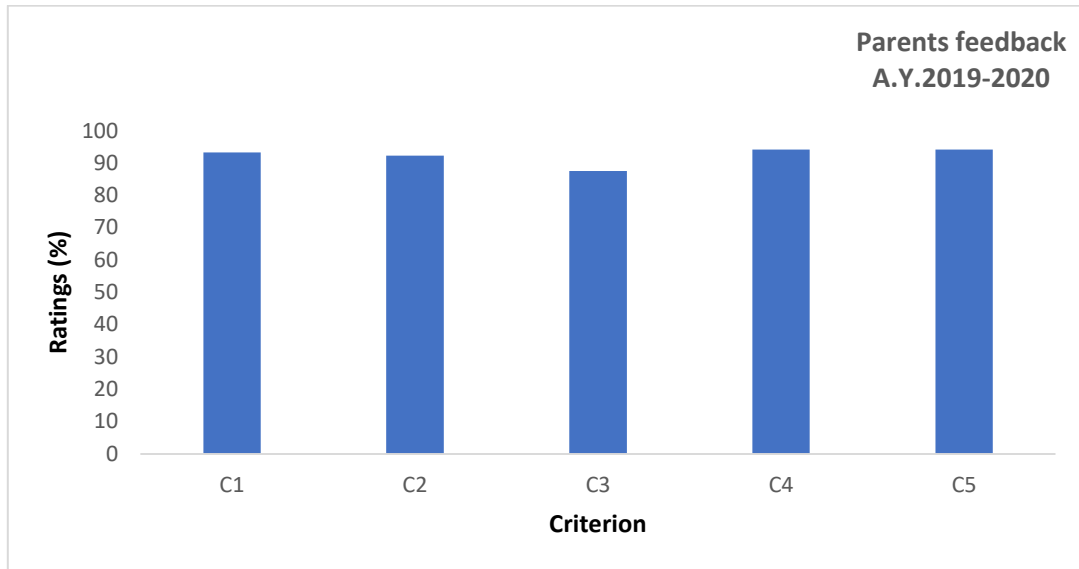


Feedback from Parents
